Rules to Govern the 2020 PIAP Elections

Rule 1

The Printing Industries Association of the Philippines, Inc. (PIAP) shall have fifteen (15) directors.

Rule 2

The directors shall hold office for one year and until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

Rule 3

The board of directors of PIAP shall have the following qualifications:

- a) He/she must be of legal age;
- b) He/she must be a regular/provincial member of PIAP for at least two (2) years or was previously elected and served as a trustee of PIAP;
- c) He/she must be a regular member of good standing, that is he/she has no unpaid liabilities to PIAP as of the deadline for submission of nominations.

Rule 4

Any member who has been convicted by final judgement of an offense punishable by imprisonment for a period exceeding six (6) years, or a violation of the Corporation Code committed within five (5) years prior to the date of his/her election or appointment shall be disqualified to serve as directors of PIAP.

Rule 5

The Corporate Secretary of PIAP shall issue at least 30 days before the election nomination forms. The nomination forms shall be submitted to the Corporate Secretary at least five (5) days from receipt. Corporate Secretary shall contact all the candidates for their acceptance or refusal of their nomination. The Corporate Secretary shall evaluate all candidates based on the qualifications and disqualifications prescribed herein, the Corporation Code and the Corporation's By-Laws. The Corporate Secretary shall endorse all qualified candidates to the general membership for election. The final list of candidates shall be circulated to the general membership at least two (2) weeks before the day of the election. Floor nominations are not allowed.

Rule 6

Regular members, provincial members and associate members in good standing, that is, those with no unpaid liabilities to PIAP as of the last day of the immediately preceding year, may vote during the election. Due to the pandemic online voting procedures will be followed. Early voting shall not be allowed.

Rule 7

All members who are qualified to vote will receive their official numbered ballot through email from the PIAP Secretariat five (5) days before the election. The members will print the ballot and fill-up and cast their fifteen (15) candidates. If the candidates voted exceed or less than fifteen (15) the entire ballot shall be invalidated.

Rule 8

Each member will post their ballots and read the fifteen (15) candidates they elected. The Comelec shall canvass the ballots read by the members.

Rules 9

No recasting of votes shall be allowed.

Rule 10

On the Election day (November 20, 2020 - Friday) the Registration starts at 6:30PM and Election proper starts at 7:30PM.

Rule 11

Candidates who intend to withdraw the candidacies must indicate so in writing and must deliver the same to the Corporate Secretary on or before 12 noon the day of the annual election.

Rule 12

The Election Committee shall announce the list of candidates (the final list of candidates, as referred to in Rule 5 less the candidates who withdrew their acceptance of their nomination, if any) prior to the casting of votes. Only those candidates announced by the Election Committee during the annual meeting shall be qualified for election.

Rule 13

All candidates shall be ranked from top to bottom with the candidate garnering the highest number of votes being on top and the candidate with lowest number of votes being on the bottom.

Rule 14

The top fifteen (15) candidates shall be elected and proclaimed as Directors of PIAP. The proclamation of the elected candidates must be done before the close of the meeting by any of the members of the election committee.

Rule 15

In case of a tie for the last slot (fifteenth slot), the first 14th winning candidates will be proclaimed and the fifteenth director shall be decided by drawing of lots on a later date.

Rule 16

In the reading and appreciation of ballots, every ballot shall be presumed to be valid unless there is clear and good reason to justify its rejection. The accidental tearing or perforation of a ballot does not annul it.

Rule 17

Proxy vote is allowed provided the proxy form is in due form, submitted and validated by the Corporate Secretary on or before November 17, 2020 at 5:00p.m..

Rule 18

Proxies must be in writing, dated, the name of the proxy and signed by the member.

Rule 19

The Corporate Secretary may adopt the following in appreciating the submitted proxy forms and the attachments, if any:

- a) If the name of the proxy is left in blank, the person to whom it is given is at liberty to fill in any name he/she/it chooses.
- b) Where the members gives two (2) or more proxies, the latest one given is to be deemed to revoke all former proxies.
- c) There shall be a presumption of regularity in the execution of proxies and shall be accepted if they have the appearance of prima facie authenticity in the absence of a timely and valid challenge.

Rule 20

Only PIAP members or their representatives authorized by duly executed proxies and authorized PIAP personnel and officers shall be allowed inside the zoom meeting. Others must first secure authorization from the President or the Corporate Secretary.


Rule 21

Any complaint regarding procedural defects shall be taken up after all votes has been casted and before canvassing of votes. Thereafter, no such complaints shall be entertained by the COMELEC (Rule 20). Protests on the result of the election shall be made in writing within 24 hours addressed to the Comelec which shall act on them within 24 hours after the close of elections. The Comelec has the sole and exclusive jurisdiction to decide all protests and complaints and its decision shall be final and unappealable.

Rule 22

The Election committee is automatically dissolved after it has canvassed the ballots and proclaimed the winning candidates.
